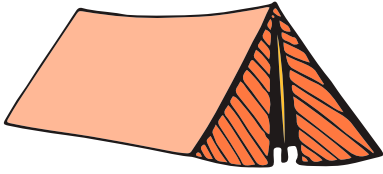


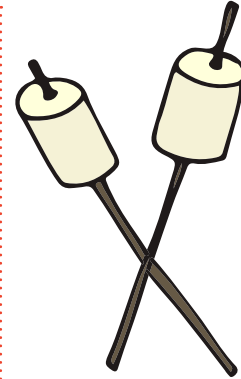
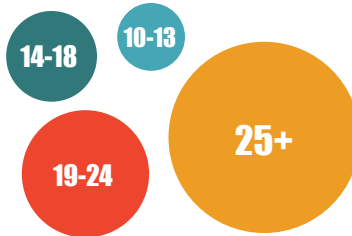

MT. HOOD KIWANIS CAMP COVERS **62%** OF THE ACTUAL COST OF CAMP

IT COSTS **\$3,450** TO PROVIDE A CAMPER A WEEK AT MHKC, AND CAMP FAMILIES PAY **\$1,300**. THIS NUMBER IS CALCULATED BY THE TOTAL NUMBER OF CAMPERS SERVED ANNUALLY VS. ANNUAL PROGRAM SPECIFIC COSTS WHICH DO NOT INCLUDE ANY COST ASSOCIATED WITH ADMINISTRATION OR FUNDRAISING.
