

2026 Summer Camp Check-In Plan

Welcome to camp! Due to construction this year camper check-in will look different. Check-in is a step-by-step process designed to keep things organized and smooth for your camper's arrival. Please follow the map and directions carefully.

Parking

- Park along the road as directed and marked on the map
- Accessible parking is available for vehicles needing ramp access

Luggage

- Staff and volunteers will be available to help carry items from your car to the check-in field
- Bring your camper's belongings to the marked walking path and up to the field
- *Don't forget to grab camper meds for check-in!*

Check-In in the Field

- Follow the path to the check-in stations
- Stay with your camper during this time
- Visit each station (staff will guide you)
- This includes communication/ behavior, nurses, and meeting your counselor

Move into Housing

- After completing check-in, bring belongings to your camper's housing area (wagons and staff available to help with luggage)
- Staff will help direct you

Good-byes

- Families and caregivers may leave once check-in stations are complete
- You do not need to stay for unpacking but you are welcome to!

Check-In Tips!

- Please label all camper belongings
- Pack light when possible due to limited space
- Expect some walking on uneven ground
- Staff are available at every step to support you

What Will Help Your Camper

- Talk through the arrival process ahead of time
- Let them know staff will help with luggage and directions
- Reassure them that camp staff will take over after check-in

2026 Summer Camp Check-Out Plan

Welcome back to camp! Due to construction this year, camper check-out will look a little different than in the past. Check-out is a step-by-step process designed to keep things organized and ensure a smooth departure for your camper.

Parking & Arrival

- Follow signs to enter camp and join the check-out loop
- Vehicles will remain in line and move slowly through the loop
- Accessible support is available as needed

Medication Pick-Up

- Nurses will be stationed at the beginning of the loop
- You will receive your camper's medications at this time

Check-Out Loop

- Continue through the loop after picking up medications
- When you reach the top of the loop, staff will call your camper
- Staff will assist your camper in bringing luggage to your vehicle

Luggage

- Camp staff will help load all camper belongings into your vehicle
- Please remain in your car unless directed otherwise

Restrooms

- Families may use the restroom when stopped at the top of the loop while campers are packing up

Departure

- Once your camper and their belongings are loaded, you will exit camp following staff directions
